What is it?

• Indicators report that tracks the state of equity in the region.

How will it be used?

- Provides demographic background information for FHEA
- To help the Coordinating Committee effectively address equity issues throughout the planning process.
- Useful tool for advocacy groups, elected officials, planners and others.

How does it relate to Our Great Region 2040?

- Provides an equity analysis to inform the plan.
- Provides some demographic background information for Fair Housing Equity Assessment (FHEA).

How was it developed?

• Relies upon data from public and private sources such as U.S. Census Bureau, the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, the Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance Survey, and Woods and Poole Economics.

Who was involved?

- Partnership between PolicyLink and PERE, the Program for Environmental and Regional Equity at the University of Southern California.
- The Coordinating Committee provided feedback on draft profile during its development.
