

# Regional Equity Profile

## What is it?

- Indicators report that tracks the state of equity in the region.

## How will it be used?

- Provides demographic background information for FHEA
- To help the Coordinating Committee effectively address equity issues throughout the planning process.
- Useful tool for advocacy groups, elected officials, planners and others.

## How does it relate to Our Great Region 2040?

- Provides an equity analysis to inform the plan.
- Provides some demographic background information for Fair Housing Equity Assessment (FHEA).

## How was it developed?

- Relies upon data from public and private sources such as U.S. Census Bureau, the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, the Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance Survey, and Woods and Poole Economics.

## Who was involved?

- Partnership between PolicyLink and PERE, the Program for Environmental and Regional Equity at the University of Southern California.
- The Coordinating Committee provided feedback on draft profile during its development.
