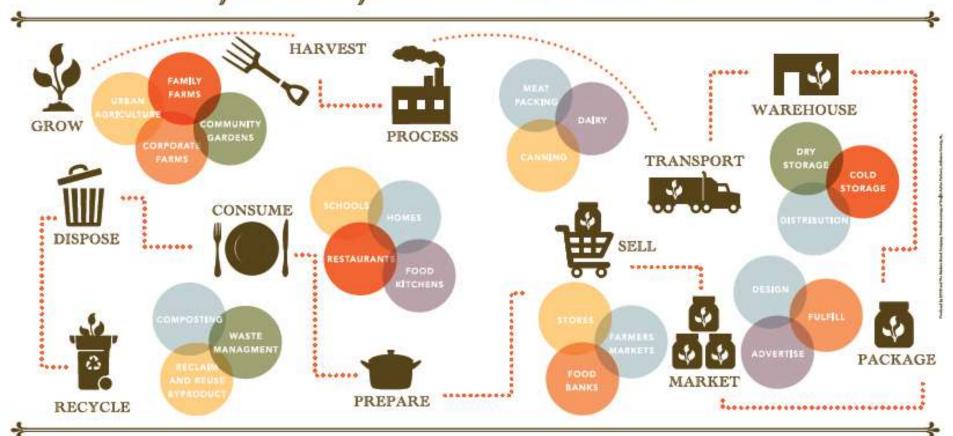
# A Healthy Food System

## DEFINED



A FOOD SYSTEM IS THE LIFE CYCLE OF GROWING, PROCESSING, TRANSPORTING, SELLING, CONSUMING AND DISPOSING OF FOOD. An effective and healthy food system makes the healthy choice the easy choice by providing sufficient quantities of safe and nutritious food to maintain a healthy diet. The healthiest system is one where food is produced, processed, transported, and marketed in ways that are respectful of our environment and the communities where they exist.

#### Fair Housing Equity Assessment Overview

#### **Purpose**


The Fair Housing Equity Assessment (FHEA) is intended to identify baseline conditions for fair housing, social equity and areas of opportunity across the region, inform deliberations of the Coordinating Committee and inform the Regional Plan for Sustainable Development.

#### **Timing**

We anticipate completing the FHEA work in Summer 2012.

#### Roles

H-GAC will lead the FHEA effort, manage third party expertise, draft the final FHEA document, and act as the local government liaison. H-GAC will draw upon the expertise of three groups throughout the FHEA process: BBC Research and Consulting, the local Fair Housing and Equity Workgroup, and the Kirwan Institute. The Fair Housing Equity Workgroup covers the regional transect and includes several local governments with housing programs, non-profits and fair housing and equity advocacy groups.



#### Components

The FHEA is comprised of 5 basic components. H-GAC will focus on a sample of local governments, representing the urban, suburban, rural and coastal areas of the region:

- Assessment of Primary Demographic Concerns
- Disparities in Access to Opportunity
- Fair Housing Activities
- Fair Housing Infrastructure/Systems
- Physical Infrastructure/Economic Investments

## **Deliverables**

The final product will be a document that identifies potential issues, provides thoughts on overcoming potential issues, and presents best practices that could be useful to communities within the region. H-GAC will present findings in context with geographic settings (i.e., urban, suburban, and rural) and community size

(i.e., town, small city, large city). Best practices and strategies will be based on proven successful efforts in peer areas from within Texas and across the nation.

<u>FHEA Communities</u> - While certain aspects of the FHEA lend themselves to a regional mapping and assessment task, several aspects will need assessment at a more local or subregional level. The following 13 counties and 29 cities representing the regional transect are known as the FHEA Communities.
